As partners in CTPAT we work closely with U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to strengthen supply chain security to counter drug trafficking, terrorism, human smuggling, child labor and illegal contraband. The partnership does that by following a multi layered security program with minimum security criteria for all the stakeholders in international supply chains. We review operations against this criterion regularly to make sure all our offices are meeting security requirements of the program. CTPAT improves border security as well as the individual supply chains of the companies that partner in the program.

We believe that security is everyone's responsibility including our employees, our agents, carriers, and other parties that we contract for services we offer to our customers. We provide training to employees and review our procedures regularly to ensure that procedures are met. We also perform risk assessments and enhance security protocols to meet the evolving security environment of supply chains.
